

VPN Connection




- 6. Click SAVE

- 11. Right click on WBA and select PROPERTIES
- 12. Go to the SECURITY TAB, make sure you have the following setup: Type of VPN: Layer 2 Tunneling Protocol with IPSec (L2TP/IPsec) Data Encryption: Require encryption Allow these protocols - only have Unencrypted Password (PAP checked)



- 14. Click OK
- 15. You can close the settings window and return to the main VPN screen. Click on the WBA entry and click on CONNECT
